### Where to apply

Our adhesive textures can be applied to **smooth and flat surfaces** in interior spaces. However, applications on surfaces regularly exposed to very high or low temperatures are not recommended.


## Before applying

### **1** Surface preparation


- **1.1** If you detect **cracks or holes in the wall**, cover them with suitable filler and let it dry for the period indicated. Use sandpaper to remove any **existing bumps or drops of paint** and eliminate any kind of **infiltration**.
- **1.2** Make sure the wall is **clean**. Use a **soft brush or cloths** and, if necessary, a **degreasing product** to remove any glue, dust or grease.
- **1.3** The application on walls that present **humidity** must be preceded by the use of a **waterproofing** agent to avoid the contamination of the adhesive and consequent detaching of the material.
- **1.4** Wall plates for **electrical and telecommunication outlets** or **switches** should be removed to ensure the surface is smooth. Don't forget to turn off the electrical current.

### **2** Preparation of the adhesive texture


- **2.1 Measure** the area of the wall, in **height and length**, where you are going to apply.
- **2.2 Cut the adhesive texture** to the desired height with a cutter or scissors, leaving a **margin** of about **5cm**, divided by 2.5cm for the ceiling area and 2.5cm for the baseboard area.
- **2.3** Repeat the process until you get the required number of panels to cover all the desired area.



### How to apply




- **1 Measure the width of the roll** with the measuring tape and make **vertical marks on the wall**, using a pencil or pen and ensuring that the size is equivalent to that of the panels.
- **Position the first panel**, in height, with paper tape and **without forgetting the margins**, 2.5cm for the ceiling area and 2.5cm for the baseboard area. Use as much adhesive tape as necessary to ensure the panel is securely attached.




- 3 Make sure the panel is aligned with the marks and use the level to confirm that it is 100% vertical.
- **4** Peel the adhesive texture from the liner, from top to bottom and about **50cm**, leaving the liner in view and the texture adhesive facing outwards.

- Fold the liner backwards, folding it with the spatula and leaving a margin of about 5cm between the crease and the adhesive texture.
- Apply the adhesive texture **from top to bottom** with the spatula, exerting pressure with **horizontal movements, from the center to the ends**, and forming a **45° angle** between both surfaces.
- Peel off the adhesive tape to allow you to pull out the remaining liner.




8 Separate the adhesive texture from the liner, between 50 and 70cm at a time, and apply it with the spatula, in a fan movement and from the center to the ends, until completing the application of the panel.



- **9** Repeat the process when applying the **following panels**, starting with step 2 and leaving a **2-5mm overlap** over the previous panel.
- Once all the panels have been applied, **cut the excess adhesive texture** with the cutter, orienting it with the spatula, in the ceiling and baseboard areas.



# Before applying




### **1** Surface preparation


- **1.1** If the furniture is in a **bad state of conservation** lack of paint, chipped wood or deformations **smooth the surface** using sandpaper or a suitable filler. In the latter case, ensure that the filler is allowed the indicated drying time.
- **1.2** Make sure the furniture is **clean**. Use a **soft brush or cloths** and, if necessary, a **degreasing product** or **ethyl alcohol** (70%) to remove glue, dust or grease residues.


### **2** Preparation of the adhesive texture

- **2.1 Measure** the areas of the furniture, in **height and length**, where you want to apply the adhesive texture.
- **2.2** Arrange the order in which you will make the necessary cutouts for all areas in order to **make the most out** of each roll.
- **2.3** Cut the adhesive texture with the corresponding measurements of the different areas, leaving a **margin** of about **1cm** on all sides.





### How to apply






- 1 Start the application at the corners, **peeling the adhesive texture from the liner** until it reaches approximately **10cm**.
- Apply the adhesive texture with the spatula, **from the center to the ends**, forming a **45° angle** between both surfaces.






- Gradually **remove the liner** on the horizontal surface and apply it to the end, following the instructions in steps 1 and 2.
- 4 If the furniture structure allows it, **fold 1 to 2cm** of the adhesive texture on the bottom of the horizontal surface.





#### **Corner details**

- **1** Make a **diagonal cut** with the cutter, starting near the corner to the **edge** of the adhesive texture.
- **Fold** the adhesive texture onto the edge with the help of the spatula.



**Fold** one of the two excess pieces of adhesive texture inward and cut it along the edge with a cutter.





**Repeat the procedure** for the second part, ensuring that the cut does not reach the adhesive texture applied in this area.

### **Helpful Tips**

#### **Positioning and symmetry**

Extra care must be taken when positioning the adhesive texture with which the application starts to ensure the correct alignment of the following ones.

### (Un)necessary strength

Moderate the strength when separating the adhesive texture from the liner and when using the spatula to avoid creases, stretches or tears.

#### Materials that must be avoided

Do not use plastic spatulas or sharp objects during application, as they can damage the adhesive texture.

#### "Wet-paint"

On recently painted walls and furniture, we recommend waiting three weeks before proceeding with the application, allowing time to cure the inks.

#### Skills in details

Applications on furniture with more demanding characteristics must be carried out in phases, starting from the horizontal part and using specific strips to cover the edges.
